Please take the time to read the bill, but the highlights are: 1) restricting the NDDoH from creating vaccination passport or machine readable code (there are private vendors, so the state doesn't want to utilize state funds for duplication), 2) state government entity nor any of its political subdivisions, agendas, or assigns may not require documentation of individuals vaccination status, 3) employers may not require vaccinations, antibodies, and post transmission recovery status, but there are exceptions to resident facilities, higher education, etc., and 4) <b>this does not apply to employer or and independent contractors required to comply with federal law, rules or guidance relating to requirements for vaccinations for COVID-19</b> *This bill has a sunset clause so will be looked at during 2023 session.
